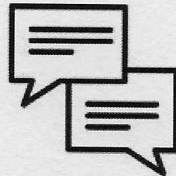

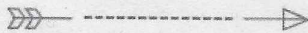

THE COUNCIL SPOKE



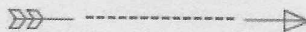
The changes to Mental Health services have been driven by the Care Act

Services will be more person-centred

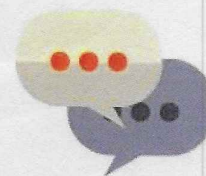


THE CCG SPOKE

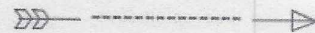


The CCG have been investing in mental health and been working in a more multidisciplinary way

Changes will start from 1st October, with some staff moving on 1st August

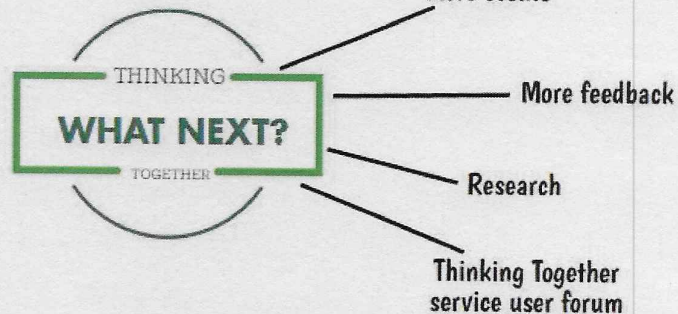
YOU SPOKE TO US
