## Two Primary Care Hubs being set up in Berkshire West

Two special Primary Care Hubs are being set up for local people who are showing symptoms of Coronavirus but don't need immediate hospital treatment.

One will be at the Walk-in Centre in Reading's Broad Street Mall and the second is being opened in a specially adapted and contained space at Newbury Racecourse East entrance.

They will only be available to patients who have already gone through a structured medical assessment. So, anyone starting to show the coronavirus symptoms of a constant cough and/or high temperature, will still initially be asked to self isolate for seven days and seek advice from [NHS 111](#) online if required.

Patients will then be referred on to their GP practice and/or one of the Hubs where appropriate.

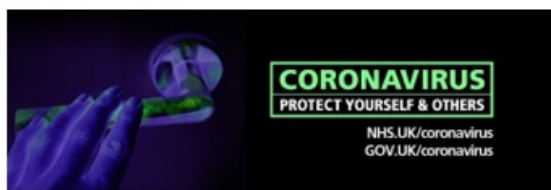
**The new Hubs are being organised by health officials from the Berkshire West Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) in partnership with local GPs. They will ease the burden on other healthcare facilities and free up hospital doctors to deal with more urgent coronavirus cases.**
